Piskarevskoe Memorial Park

Located in St. Petersburg. The memorial complex designed by Alexander Vasiliev and Yevgeniy Levinson was opened on May 9, 1960. About 420,000 civilians and 50,000 soldiers of the Leningrad Front were buried in 186 mass graves.

St. Petersburg Crematorium

The Crematorium of St. Petersburg is a subdivision of the St. Petersburg State Unitary Enterprise "Funeral Services", which is under the jurisdiction of the Committee for the Development of Entrepreneurship and Consumer Market of St. Petersburg. In January 12, 1996, Federal Law has granted it the burial and funeral Business."

Vagankovo Cemetery

The Vagankovo cemetery is one of the largest cemeteries in Russia. Its area is nearly 50 hectares. According to official record, the cemetery was founded in 1771.

Mitinsky Cemetery

The whole world remembers one of the main catastrophes of the 20th century - the accident at the Chernobyl nuclear power plant. It happened exactly 33 years ago. 134 people suffered radiation sickness, more than 115 thousand residents were evacuated, more than 600 thousand people participated in the aftermath. Today, a rally of memory was held at Mitinsky cemetery.
